Criteria for grants &/or projects for funding

Eligible Institutions

- Organizations, lay or religious, headquartered in the Philippines, in the US or anywhere outside of the Philippines with at least a 2 year history of achievement and effective management of serving the poor and underprivileged in the Philippines and/or are operating strictly for the benefit of the Filipinos or migrant Filipinos;
- Institutions and organizations who are of sound financial condition, as demonstrated by their current, certified, audited financial statements prepared in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles;
- Institutions and organizations in the Philippines or the US with at least a 2 year history of achievement and effective management of operations, and whose mission is aligned with the mission of Kerygma Family, i.e. evangelization, charitable work for the poor, underprivileged, elderly, the youth, the dispossessed etc.

Program criteria

- Programs and projects that respond to a compelling need and are consistent with the Kerygma Family's vision/mission including but not limited to:
 - A. Spiritually-oriented TV programs in the Philippines
 - B. Spiritually-oriented Radio programs in the Philippines
 - C. Spiritually-oriented Video/audio production
 - D. Spiritually-oriented Websites and other means through the internet to reach more Filipinos in the Philippines and migrant Filipinos
 - E. Spiritually-oriented Live spiritual events in the Philippines or abroad
 - F. Spiritually-oriented Pastoral Community prayer & teaching gatherings
 - G. Spiritually-oriented Counselling services
 - H. Providing housing and/or housing assistance to the homeless Filipino
 - I. Providing scholarship privileges for the Filipino youth to give them opportunities for better education
 - J. Providing health care assistance and privileges for the rural and urban poor
- Programs that have the potential to exert a measurable impact on the chances for success of a project that directly relates to the economic and spiritual well-being of the Filipino and/or the intended beneficiary/beneficiaries.
- New and/or ongoing programs that have as their primary mission, the urban and rural poor, the homeless, the abandoned elderly in the Philippines

Projects ineligible for funding

- Routine institutional or general operating expenses, deficit reduction, or general or administrative overhead expenses;
- General campaigns, including fundraising events, dinners or mass mailings;
- Grants to individuals
